

San Diego High School National Honor Society Welcome Information



Membership in the National Honor Society is one of the highest honors that can be awarded to a high school student. NHS has worked hard to bring the accomplishments of outstanding students to the attention of parents, teachers, peers and the community. There are rules for membership that are based upon a student's outstanding performance in the areas of scholarship, service, leadership and character. These 4 criteria for selection form the foundation upon which the organization and its activities are built.

Membership in the National Honor Society is based upon outstanding *scholarship* (3.5 or greater weighted GPA), strong *leadership*, active school and/or community *service*, and exemplary *character* (to be recognized by the SDHS staff as an honest, trustworthy, dependable person). The first time eligibility is determined for NHS is after the fall semester of the freshmen year. There is not a set quota or percentage of members per class. Students who meet the criteria and recommended by the faculty council should and will be inducted regardless of the number of students seeking membership.

Candidate Selection Process - At the beginning of the 2nd Semester, the NHS advisor will ask guidance for an updated report on student GPAs to determine if any students became eligible with the close of the last academic semester. Those newly eligible students will be sent a congratulatory letter at school indicating their eligibility based on scholarship, attendance, and disciplinary actions. All eligible candidates interested in being considered for membership will need to fill out and submit the SDHS NHS application. Please note that eligibility does **NOT** guarantee membership. Students who do not turn in their application by the deadline will **NOT** be eligible to join the NHS that current year. Students who follow all the directions and who are invited to join the NHS will be sent congratulatory letters with the date of the induction ceremony.

If you feel that you are eligible and **do not** receive a letter, please speak to Ms. Aguilar. It is **your** responsibility to be aware of deadlines, reminders will not be sent.

Criteria for Selection

- Scholarship: Teacher Recommendation (0-4 points) and Outside Recommendation (0-2 points)
- Leadership: Parts 3-6 of Application (0-4 points)
- Service: Verification of service hours earned up to time of application (0-4 points)
- Character: Teacher/Outside Recommendations/Essay (0-10 points)

A minimum of 16 points is required for selection.

Applicant TO DO checklist:

- Complete Parts 1 7 of application. Hand Write (If a digital form is needed, please request and use KAMI to open to complete and print.).
- Complete Part 8 (the essay) on a separate sheet or document. Maximum of 200-300 words. Must be TYPE and printed or submitted electronically.
- Remove and turn in Part 9 (along with a blank envelope) to the person in your community you are asking for a recommendation. Recommendation should be sealed in an envelope when turned in.
- Remove and turn in Part 10 (along with a blank envelope) to **TWO** of your current teachers (1 core teacher and 1 elective teacher)
- Retrieve all envelopes from your outside recommender and teachers and then place everything in an 8 ½ by 11 manila envelope. On the front of the envelope, you should put your name and "NHS application".

Explain how those values support your academic success and service to others. It should answer the following questions:

- Why should you be selected for SDHS National Honor Society?
- Write about a specific time you exemplified leadership and what you learned from it?
- Explain in detail how you would carry out a specific service project to benefit your community.

Spelling, grammar and neatness along with quality of response will be part of the evaluation process. Your typed, double-spaced essay should be thoughtful, well-planned, and written for a formal, discerning audience. Please include your name on the back of the essay to maintain anonymity in scoring. **This is to be written only by the applicant.**
